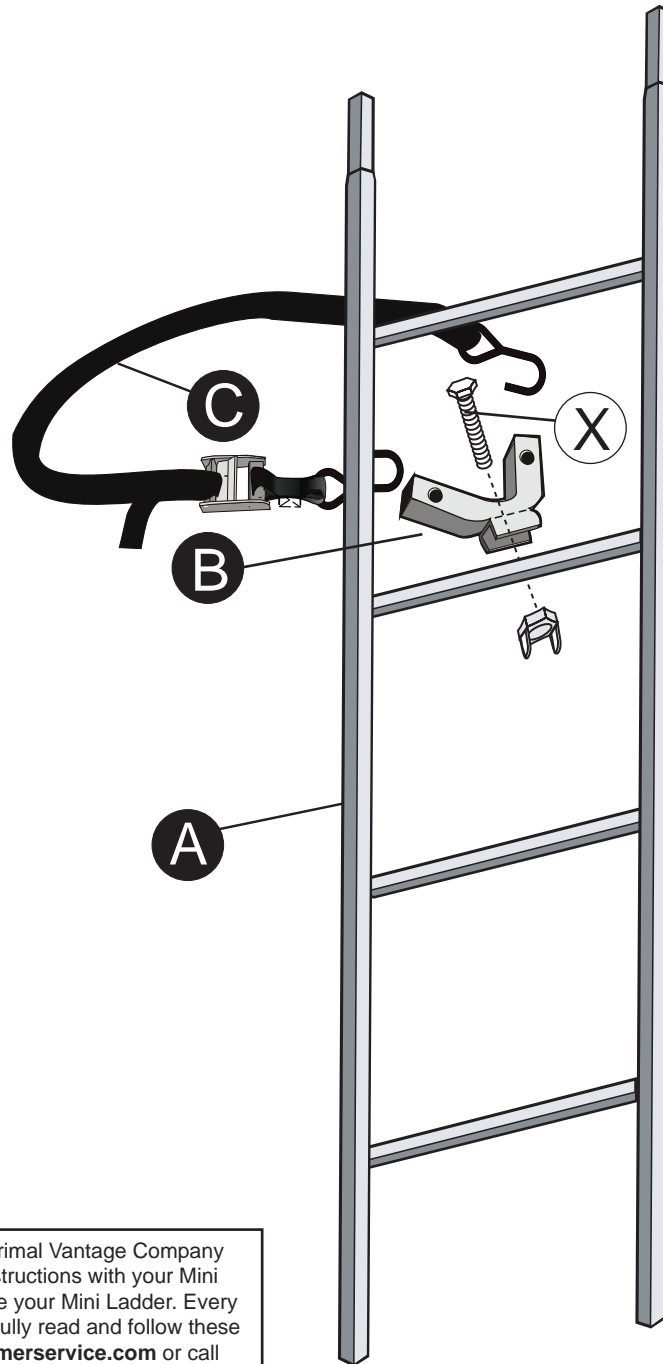

# SGSL-121 20 Ft Mini Ladder Assembly Instructions

## ⚠ WARNING ⚠ WARNING ⚠

1. Attach Tree Brace **B** to Mini Ladder Section **A** using **1-M8x45mm Bolt with wingnut**. Wingnuts must be installed facing away from tree. **(Fig. 1)**. Tighten securely.
2. Assemble all ladder sections together **(Fig. 2)**. Make sure all connections are tightened securely.
3. Stand the assembled Mini Ladder upright against the tree so that all of the Tree Braces are firmly against the tree. The Mini Ladder must be straight and vertical. **DO NOT** use on a leaning or dead tree. Tree should have a diameter between 9 and 20 inches.
4. Press your weight on the first step so that the base of the bottom section settles firmly and completely into the ground.
5. Attach Buckle Strap Assembly **C** to Tree Brace **B**. **(See Fig. 3)**. Insert the hook into one of the holes on the tree brace. Wrap the strap around the back of the tree. Insert the other hook into the other hole on the tree brace. Make sure that the strap is flat against tree with no slack. **(Fig. 3)**. **(See Detailed S-hook Buckle and Strap Instructions)**. Pull the strap tight to secure section to the tree before climbing.
6. Attach Safety Harness to yourself and the tree according to the manufacturer's instructions.
7. Climb the bottom section of the Mini Ladder to reach the Second Section. Attach the second strap. Make sure section is secure before climbing any further.
8. Repeat for each remaining section.
9. When removing mini ladder sections do not undo any strap until you are standing securely on the section below it.

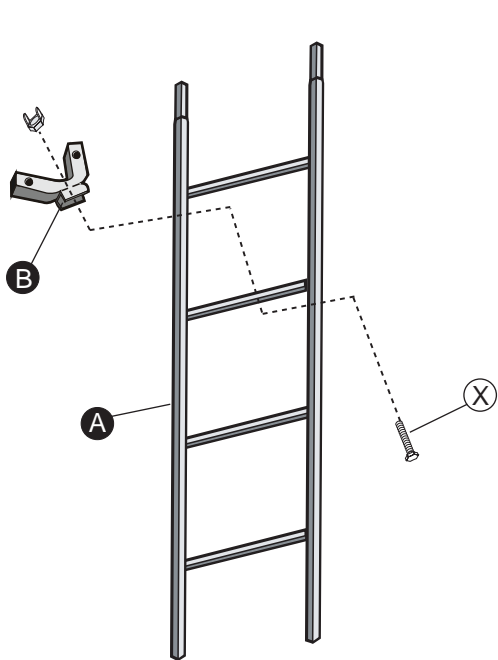

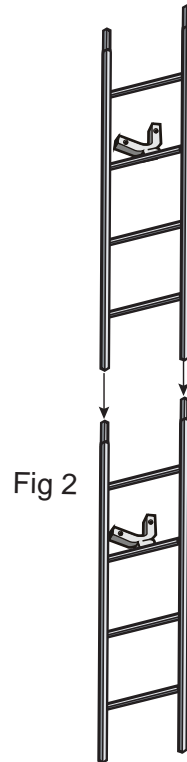

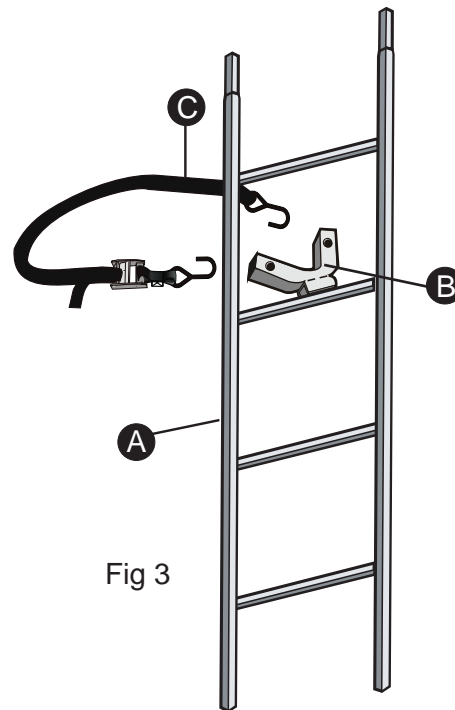

# DETAILED S-HOOK BUCKLE AND STRAP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Hold buckle as shown in (Fig. 1)

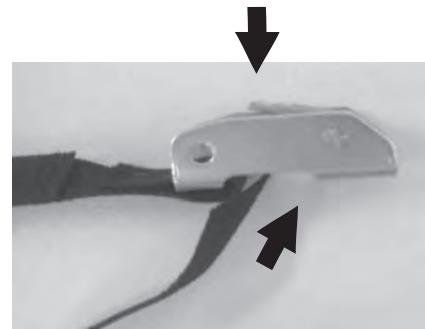

2. Press down on latch and insert strap underneath teeth and flat piece of metal as shown in (Fig. 2).

3. Pull strap to desired length. (Fig. 3)

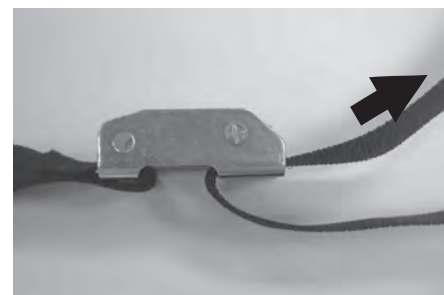

4. Wrap strap around tree and insert hooks into holes on tree brace. Pull slack until tightened. (Fig. 4)

**Always** tug on strap to make sure it is secured by the buckle
