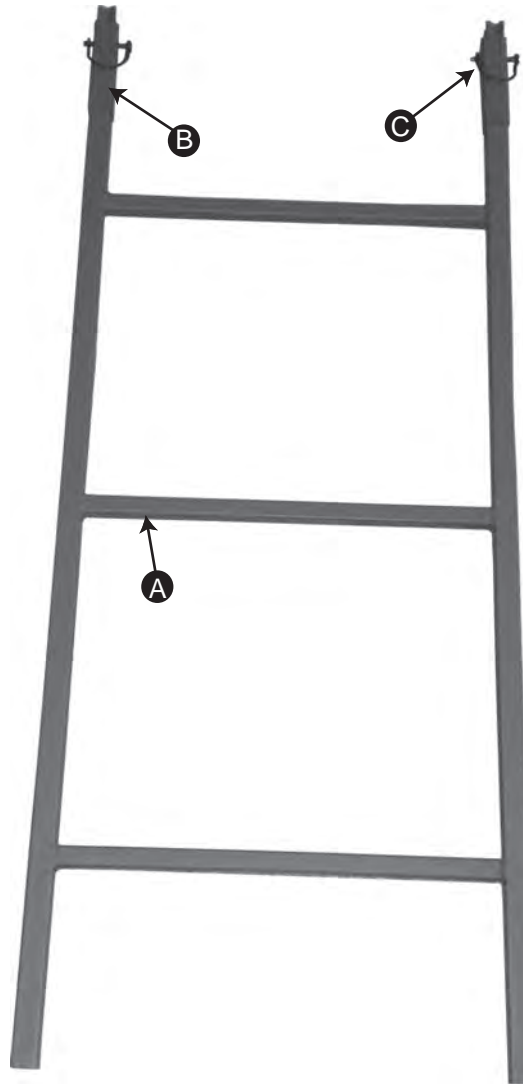

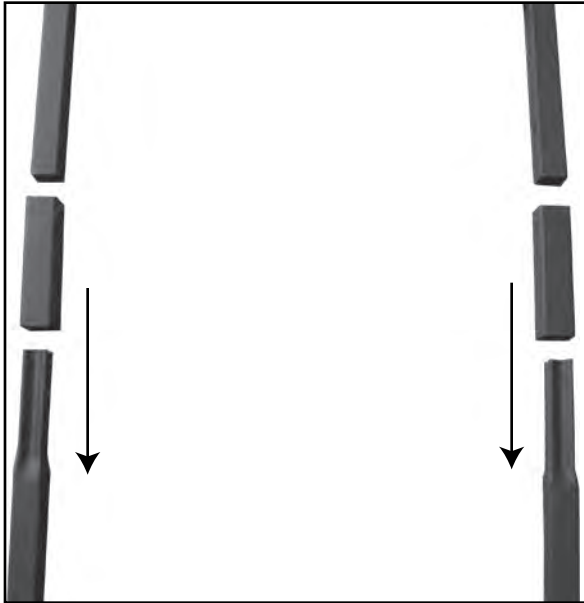

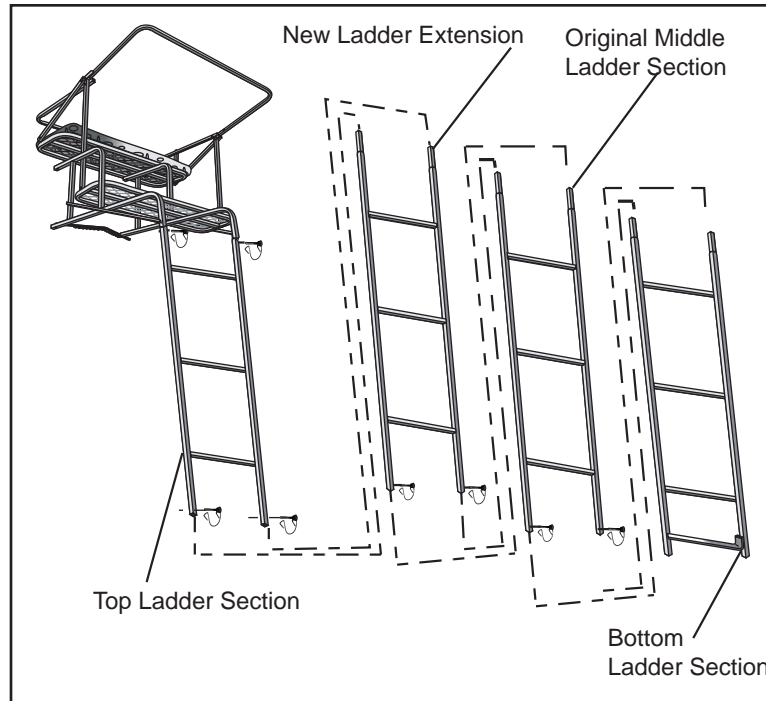

Weight limit of this ladderstand is **500 lbs.** **DO NOT** use ladder stand if your combined weight of one person and equipment exceeds **300 lbs.** or combined weight of two people and equipment exceeds **500 lbs.** **DO NOT exceed the weight limit of safety harness, refer to harness manufacturers warnings for weight limit of safety harness.**

1. With the help of at least two other people, lower your original stand to the ground. Disconnect the quickclips holding the original middle ladder section to the original top ladder section.
2. Slide Sleeves onto crimped section of the new ladder section
3. Insert new ladder section into top ladder section.
4. Slide Sleeves over joints where the two sections meet and insert 1-Quickclip through the sleeve and ladder sections.
5. Re-install the quickclips into each ladder section.

DETAILED BUCKLE AND STRAP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Hold buckle as shown in Fig. 1

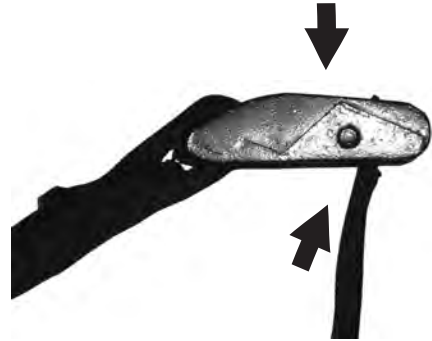

2. Press down on latch and insert strap underneath teeth as shown in Fig. 2.

3. Pull strap to desired length.

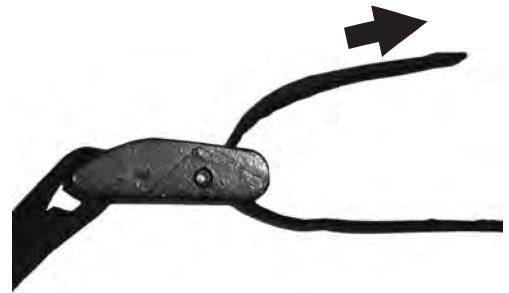

4. Pull slack to tighten.
(See Fig. 4)

ALWAYS tug on strap to make sure it is secured by the buckle before use
